Holy Week Worship

We continue our preparations for Easter and celebrate Jesus' faithfulness to his call with a worship service that will look at the last 24 hours or so of Jesus' life (what we call Maundy Thursday and Good Friday) with a worship gathering on Thursday, March 29 at 7:00pm. We will celebrate the disciples gathering with Jesus at table for the Last Supper and mourn as Jesus is nailed to the cross the next day.

On Friday, March 30 (Good Friday) and Saturday, March 31 (Holy Saturday), the sanctuary will be open for a time of individual prayer and reflection. Friday the sanctuary will be available from 3:00pm-9:00pm and Saturday from 10:00am-3:00pm. There will be prayer/reflection materials available as well as contemplative music playing.

Easter Sunday will start with a potluck breakfast at 9:00am (with Pastor Seth's beignets) before we gather for worship at 10:00am.

Christian Formation

We were very fortunate to have very limited facility needs in 2017. That has seemed to change in 2018. We have had plumbing maintenance done at the parsonage that has cost almost \$2,000. This work included replacing many of the pipes in the house that were not to code, moving the shut-off valve so it can be quickly accessed in an emergency (it used to be 15ft back in the crawl space), replacing both toilets, and fixing the kitchen faucet. We are also replacing Terry's office computer this month as it is old and getting older and starting to have negative effects on office productivity.

Increased expenses in January also reflect several annual or semiannual expenses that must be paid in January.
